

## REQUEST TICKETS

## DEPOSIT

After submitting your request, you will receive an email with a reservation invoice.  
We require a 25% deposit, due within 1 week of receiving your invoice,  
to hold your reservation.

## PAYMENT

Final payment is due as noted on your reservation invoice.  
**(2 weeks prior to the scheduled performance date)**  
Submit the invoice and payment to our Business Manager for processing.

## FINAL NUMBERS

Groups may decrease their ticket numbers or cancel their reservation before payment is due 2  
weeks prior to the performance date; however, once full payment is received, all sales are final.  
After that time, you may still increase your numbers, subject to availability.

Update your head count well in advance. If your number drastically increases,  
you may not be able to get seats; if it decreases, you may have to pay for unused tickets.
